## 2019 fact sheet EN standards for practice

The scope of practice of an EN and RN are different. An EN must work under the direct/indirect supervision of an RN at all times. An EN should only be carrying out practice that they are appropriately trained and competent to do, and which is within their scope of practice. This does not include working at the level of an RN.

## National Guidelines for Nursing Delegation - American ...

A delegatee may be an RN, LPN/VN or AP. Delegator: One who delegates a nursing responsibility. A delegator may be APRN, RN, or LPN/VN (where state NPA allows). Assignment: The routine care, activities and procedures that are within the authorized scope of practice of the RN or LPN/VN or part of the routine functions of the AP.
